



# Performance Cup Canada

## Code of Conduct 2026 Agreement

This Code of Conduct (“Code”) applies to all individuals participating in, representing, or affiliated with any team or entrant competing in Performance Cup Canada (“PCC”), including drivers, team owners, crew members, contractors, volunteers, guests, sponsors, affiliates, and any other persons present at or associated with a PCC-sanctioned event. Compliance with this Code is a condition of participation. By entering any PCC event, all individuals acknowledge and agree to be bound by its terms.

**Team Owner Responsibility** — The Team Owner is solely responsible for ensuring compliance with this Code by all associated persons. Violations may result in disciplinary action against the individual, driver, team, or any combination thereof. Ignorance of this Code is not a defense.

**Standards of Conduct** — PCC is founded on honesty, integrity, and respect. All participants must conduct themselves in a professional manner at all times. Abusive, hostile, threatening, or confrontational behavior is prohibited. Disputes must be addressed respectfully through appropriate channels.

**Harassment and Abuse** — Harassment, discrimination, bullying, intimidation, threats, or abusive conduct—verbal, physical, written, or digital—are prohibited. Social media activity relating to PCC is considered an extension of the racetrack.

**Media and Publicity** — All participants consent to photographs, video, and audio recordings for promotional, educational, broadcast, or commercial use without compensation. Key team personnel, including but not limited to team owners, drivers, crew chiefs, and mechanics, may be approached for interviews or commentary at the discretion of PCC.

**Safety and Conduct** — Participants must act safely and responsibly in all areas. Drivers must avoid reckless or retaliatory actions. Following any on-track incidents, individuals shall refrain from confrontational behavior and allow PCC officials to manage the matter.

**Alcohol and Substances** — Alcohol or impairing substances during competition hours or safety-critical duties are prohibited.

**Compliance and Enforcement** — Participants must comply with instructions from PCC officials. Penalties may include warnings, fines, loss of points, disqualification, suspension, or revocation of privileges. PCC reserves the right to apply penalties to individuals, drivers, or entire teams based on the nature and severity of the violation.
